Wondering how to stretch your budget this school year?

Let NMC and Feeding America help! Free fresh foods, fruits, vegetables, and more are available to all students through our grant-funded Mobile Food Pantry program.

**ALL Students are able to use this program: there are no means tests or financial measures to participate.**

**All students** are encouraged to use this free resource. Each recipient receives approximately 7-10 days of fresh fruit, produce, and other goods on a first come, first serve basis.

Hop in the car line in the Maple Lot on the Front Street Campus and drive through the distribution loop. Food will be loaded into your trunk. No car? No problem! You're welcome to "walk through" and receive goods in a carry-able way. Bring a backpack or reusable bags.
